## BACKGROUND AND OBJECTIVE

### ABOUT THE PROJECT

**Bridge for Researchers Going to Europe – Step II** is a 24-month long EURAXESS project to support the long-term careers of 300 highly skilled refugee researchers and their integration into the labour markets of the European Union member states and its associated countries. It provides high quality guidance, mentoring and training for refugee researchers, especially postdocs and professors displaced for more than two years in Greece, Bulgaria, Serbia, Austria, Switzerland, Germany and Sweden.

One important task of BRIDGEII project is to create a **pilot peer group of researchers in danger (RD)** of various nationalities, living in European countries. This task focusses in bringing together RD on their path to a future career. Therefore, the University of the Aegean and Bielefeld University in collaboration with the German Syrian Research Society will invite RD in discipline groups to collaborate and share knowledge and build up peer mentoring relationships. The pilot group will meet at 7<sup>th</sup> of October in Mytilene (Lesvos – Greece) is going to

1. Bring together 20 RD from all disciplines (humanities, social sciences, life sciences, natural sciences) to exchange their experience
2. Discuss and define the strategic priorities, which are important for an effective pilot peer group of RD at European scale (i.e. information exchange, use of existing social networks, new IT tools etc).
3. Discuss existing networks, IT tools (i.e. social network platforms, E-mail), knowledge inventories, best practices of existing initiatives in the topic will be examined in order to set the main path for the pilot peer group formation.
4. Plan next activities of the “peer group”

## METHODOLOGY

The methodology of the meeting is based on the concept of the “Pro Action Café”, which is a methodology for creative and inspirational conversations. Participants are invited to share their questions (around projects – seed ideas) and get group input from others. In a Pro Action Café, topics are brought forward by participants themselves. There is no set agenda, only overall guiding questions, ideas and “setting-the-scene” presentation with the intention of deepening the learning process of all participants. Pro Action Café combines both the concepts of World Café and Open Space Technology. From World Café is the usage of tables, from Open Space is the idea of self-organised agenda building and session hosting incorporated. Short setting-the-scene presentations provide a possibility for BRIDGE II RR and invited stakeholders to bring in key information. After the Introduction and the setting the scene presentations, there are three rounds of conversation in café style – each guided by a few generic questions to help deepen and focus the conversations.

- (1) **Round 1:** *"What is the quest behind the question/project?"* —
- (2) **Round 2:** *"What is missing?"*
- (3) **Round 3:** *"What am I learning about myself?"* — *"What am I learning about my project?"* — *"What next steps will I take?"* — *"What help do I still need?"*

In each round, a new set of participants joins together at the tables, benefiting from the collective intelligence present during the event.
